Protocol for the award ceremony

It is desirable that the student(s) who have produced the project be there to receive the Prize and their certificate. However, when a group wins the Prize, GRIS-Montréal or GRIS-Québec as the case may be, will only reimburse the expenses incurred for ONE representative and the adult who has accompanied the former. The students' parents are invited to attend the ceremony but their expenses will be not reimbursed.

GRIS Montreal and GRIS Québec will be able to broadcast the following regarding the nomination file: the name of the school, a description of the project, all of the information found in the Nomination File which does not allow the identification of individuals, as well as the names and photographs of the adults taken during the award ceremony.

For all other information, such as the names of students who produced the project or who took part, photographs taken at the ceremony which could identify minors, and the like, GRIS-Montreal and GRIS-Québec, as the case may be, undertake to respect the wishes of the Staff Person and the parent(s)' authorization will be required to broadcast any and all information which could identify minors.
